What is Discord?

<u>Discord</u> is a popular free communication platform that allows users to interact through text, voice, and video. Users can join or create servers, which are essentially chat rooms organized around a specific topic.

You can <u>integrate your MIDAS booking system</u> with your organization's Discord server with our optional addon, in order to receive notifications in your Discord server when certain activity occurs within your room booking system.

MIDAS integration with Discord

One of the features included as standard with our MIDAS room booking software is a powerful "Watch" feature.

Watches allow users to set up automated notifications which trigger when specific activity occurs within their MIDAS booking system.

For example, you could set up a Watch notification rule to automatically send an email catering staff whenever refreshments are added to bookings. Alternatively, you could create a Watch rule to notify your finance team whenever an invoice has been paid.

MIDAS is able to integrate with Discord through our optional Discord addon. This allows Watch notifications from MIDAS to appear in your organization's Discord server in real-time.

Prerequisites

In order to use this optional addon for your MIDAS booking system, you will need to be running MIDAS v4.40 (or later) and have an active Discord server for your organization.

Installing the Addon

The Discord addon is available as an option for MIDAS v4.19 (or later) and can be purchased together with MIDAS, or added at a later stage.

- To add the Discord addon to an existing MIDAS booking system, please go to MIDAS Admin
 Options → Manage Addons → Available Addons → Discord.

After purchase, the Discord addon will become available for one-click installation via MIDAS Admin Options \rightarrow Manage Addons \rightarrow Addons Ready To Install \rightarrow Discord.

Once installed, you'll need to <u>obtain a Discord WebHook URL</u>, and then <u>configure the addon</u> via MIDAS Admin Options \rightarrow Manage Addons \rightarrow Installed Addons \rightarrow Discord.




Obtain a Zoom WebHook URL

In order to allow your MIDAS to post notifications to your Discord server, you will need to obtain a Discord WebHook URL.

A 'WebHook' is a unique URL that authorizes your MIDAS system to post notifications directly to your Discord server.


You can obtain a WebHook URL for your Discord server as follows:

1) Login to your Discord account, right-click on your Discord server, and select Server Settings → Integrations.






2) On the Integrations screen, select "Webhooks".




3) Select "New Webook":


4) Give your new Webhook a name (for example "MIDAS"), and select the "channel" within your server that you wish notifications to be posted to (for example #general).





5) Select the "Copy Webhook URL" button to copy your unique WebHook URL to the clipboard. (You'll need to paste this into the Discord <u>addon settings</u> page within MIDAS)



Addon Settings



The Discord Addon administrative interface (MIDAS Admin Options \rightarrow Manage Addons \rightarrow Installed Addons \rightarrow Discord)



From this screen you can configure Discord integration...

Send Watch Notifications to Discord

This box enables or disables the posting of Watch Notifications to your Discord server.

Discord WebHook URL

In order for your MIDAS to be able to send notifications to your Discord server, you'll need to <u>obtain a Discord WebHook URL</u>, and enter this URL into this field.

Use the following user's Watch settings to post notifications to Discord

This drop-down list displays all current users who have access to the "Watch" features of MIDAS.

Select a user from this list for their current Watch triggers to be used to decide what notifications are posted to your Discord server.

Once correctly configured, you'll then begin to see notifications appearing in your Discord server when relevant Watch notifications are triggered within MIDAS.
